Candidate Eligibility Requirements:

All candidates must meet minimum academic standards for participation as set forth by the Mentor High School Student Government Constitution in Article I, Section II (minimum 2.5 GPA and good standing in one's class).

Class Senators:

The class senators must report to class presidents. The class senators must attend executive class meetings and student government meetings. The class senators are responsible for organizing and administrating student government functions and projects. The class senators shall have further powers, duties, and limitations as assigned.

This form does not guarantee neither acceptance nor appointment to the applied position. This form is merely intended to evaluate your eligibility and potential as a senator.
